



## 2008 Bassmaster Weekend Series “Championship” Mercury Marine Bonus Eligibility

### Boater Guidelines:

1. To receive the Mercury Championship bonus, Mercury owners **must be the original registered owner/first purchaser**, and must have purchased a 2006 or newer Mercury outboard engine. The acceptable engine horsepower range is 115 hp through 300 hp. (Mercury Racing and MerCruiser engines are excluded from this bonus regardless of horsepower.) **It is the responsibility of the angler to make sure the engine is registered in their name with Mercury prior to competing. Non-registered engines will not be eligible.** Warranty registration line is (920)-929-5054. Note: For engines purchased from Mercury pro staff, please call the warranty line to confirm registration eligibility. **Also, please double-check the boat and engine registration separately as the registration process may differ in regards to first purchaser criteria.**
2. Entrant must provide proof of ownership to the tournament organizer (ABA) on or before the tournament registration. Proof of ownership is defined as Mercury warranty registration card or MSO title, or state license documentation registration that identifies the tournament participant as the owner. Entrant must use this engine for the tournament
3. No competitive outboard manufacturer logos or trademarks may be displayed on the participant's apparel or equipment used in the tournament
4. Mercury Marine reserves the right to make the final decision in all matters regarding contingency eligibility, and to change or discontinue this bonus program at anytime without notice.

### Non-Boater

1. To receive the Mercury Championship bonus, Mercury owners **must be the original registered owner/first purchaser**, and must have purchased a 2006 or later model year Mercury outboard engine. The acceptable engine horsepower range is 115 hp through 300 hp. (Mercury Racing and MerCruiser engines are excluded from this bonus regardless of horsepower.) **It is the responsibility of the angler to make sure the engine is registered in their name with Mercury prior to competing. Non-registered engines will not be eligible.** Warranty registration line is (920)-929-5054. Note: For engines purchased from Mercury pro staff, please call the warranty line to confirm registration eligibility. **Also, please double-check the boat and engine registration separately as the registration process may differ in regards to first purchaser criteria.**
